



# Osborne Treatment Centre at Home Service

Cancer Services Produced: Apr 2024

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#### What is the Osborne Treatment Centre at Home Service?

This service has been set up to give patients their treatment in their home. The nurse will visit patients at a given date/time and give treatments that will take less than an hour and are safe to be given in their home.

### How you will know when we are coming?

Your consultant will decide if you are suitable to have your treatment at home and refer you to us.

We will contact you to confirm we have received your referral and give you a date and time for when your nurse will visit.

We will send you a reminder text message to make sure your bloods are done so the nurse can authorise your treatment.

A reminder will then be sent the day before your visit to tell you to take your pretreatment tablets (where it applies) at least an hour before your visit time. If you don't, the nurse will be unable to give your treatment.

#### We will

- Tell you if we need to make any changes to your visit date or time slot via our messaging service.
- Treat your house as we would our own and respect your wishes where we are able to.

# We ask you to

- Make sure you have your blood test taken \_\_\_\_\_days before your visit date.
- Make sure you take your pre-treatment tablets (where it applies) at least an hour before your visit time.
- Allow your nurse to carry out the treatments as planned.
- Contact us in advance if you are feeling unwell and need to change your visit date.
- Make sure no-one smokes in the room whilst your treatment is being given.
- Make sure any animals are locked away in a separate room whilst the nurse is in your house.
