Introduction

This department is on Level 1, Balmoral Building.

This service is a same day emergency care unit for patients coming to the hospital with medical concerns. This service aims to support earlier discharge and avoid you being admitted to hospital where possible.

After seeing a senior doctor you may need tests and investigations. Please be aware that sometimes this can take a number of hours.

Patients are always welcome to ask staff any questions.

Please be aware that only 1 person can stay with each patient due to space in the department.

The department does not have an appointment system. Patients are seen in time order, however some patients who are unwell may be seen sooner.

What can I expect?

When you arrive you will be booked in by a receptionist and asked to sit in the waiting room. If the team feel it is needed some patients will be able to rest on a trolley while they wait to be seen.

You will be seen by a nurse who will record your observations and ask about your illness. After this a doctor will see you and ask for any tests that may be needed. The doctor may refer you to be assessed by a Senior Clinician at this point. Who will discuss the plan for your care.

Please be aware that sometimes this can take a number of hours depending on your treatment. Treatments and investigations may involve a number of visits to SDEC.

SDEC can make referrals for follow-up appointments or book general medical clinics after your discharge. A letter will be sent to your GP to advise of next steps.

Please be aware that sometimes, depending on what is wrong, you may need to be admitted to hospital. The team will discuss this with you on the day.

General information
