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Introduction

Dear patients, families, and caregivers.

Welcome to our Stroke Rehabilitation Unit on ward 3, Leicester General Hospital. We understand this is a difficult time for you and your family. We are here to support you. Recovery from a stroke can take a long time and not everyone will recover.

Our team includes nurses, doctors, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, and speech and language therapists. **They** will work with you during your stay.

What is rehabilitation?

Rehabilitation helps you to re-learn skills that you may have lost. Therapists can work with you to set goals for your recovery. Time to practice is very important for your recovery.

What to expect:

- Therapy sessions are an important part of your recovery, but rehabilitation happens in other ways too.
- Getting out of bed each day and doing exercises by yourself or with family or friends are all part of the process.
- We aim to see each patient at least 3 times a week for therapy sessions. This may be
 in a group session or 1 to 1 with a therapist. You will be given extra exercises and
 activities in your blue folder for you to practice by yourself.
- Please take part in group activities and speak with other patients. The support and company of others who are going through similar experiences can be helpful.

Please ask your family members or care givers to make sure you are ready to take part by bringing you clothing, toiletries and small belongings.

Clothing:

- Comfortable and loose-fitting clothing that is easy to get on and off.
- Suitable shoes or slippers with non-slip soles.

Toiletries:

Your personal toiletries, including toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, and any other personal hygiene items you may need during your stay.

Small personal belongings

Photographs or small familiar objects from home will also help.

How long will I stay?

- How long you will stay in our Stroke Rehabilitation Unit depends on how big your stroke is and the progress you make. On average, patients stay with us for about 6 weeks. Your real stay may vary in length as this is only an estimate.
- We will arrange a meeting together with family or carers and your therapists. This is to keep everyone updated in the first 3 weeks of your stay.
