

How to fit a replacement earmould to your hearing aid

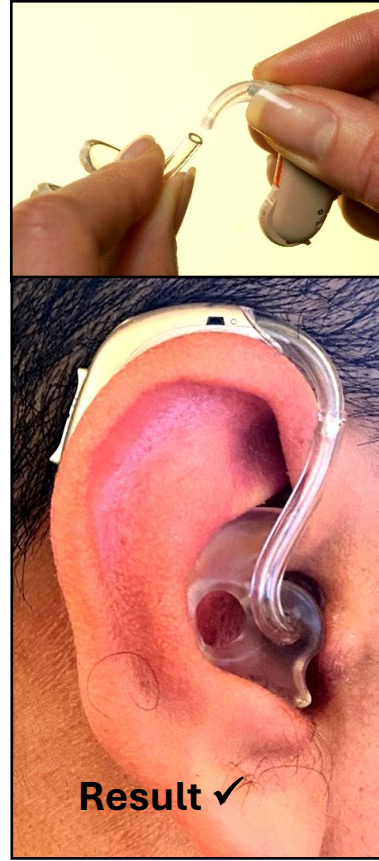
Fitting instructions:

1. Remove the old mould from your hearing aid.
2. The new mould will already have a piece of tubing in it. This will be too long.
3. Simply hold the new mould against the old one and cut the tube to the same length. Or place the new mould in your ear and the hearing aid behind your ear. Ask someone else to mark where they meet. Remember to leave a little extra tubing for the tube to push over the end of the hearing aid. Cut the tube.
4. If you are not sure, it is better to cut it too long than too short. You can always remove a little bit extra tubing. However, when you have removed too much, you cannot add it back on and will need another new tube to be added.
5. If you have also been given a soft pink/green impression, you can throw this away in your normal waste bin.
