Why do you keep information about me?

We aim to give you the best possible health care. To do this, we have to keep records about you. These records include sensitive information about your health and the treatment we (and others) have given (or plan to give) to you.

The records we keep are:

- your name, address, date of birth, age, gender and emergency contact details.
- clinic letters, referrals and notes about your appointments.
- test results and images, such as scans, X-rays and photographs.
- other information that may affect your health condition.

We protect your personal information and make sure that only the staff who need to know in order to care for you can see it.

Your rights

You have a right to know what information we hold about you. To ask for a copy of your medical record, contact the Access to Health Records team on 0300 303 1563 (option 3). In most cases, there's no charge for this service unless it is for something extra that is not in a usual medical record, like a medical report allowing you to fly.

If any information we have is wrong, you'd like other information or want to complain about our data usage, contact the Privacy Unit by email: infogov@uhl-tr.nhs.uk or the Patient Information and Liaison Service on 0808 178 8337.

We cannot delete or stop using your information if it would stop us being able to treat you if you need medical care.

Who might my information be shared with?

We may share information with our partner organisations so that we can give you the best care and to protect your best interests. These organisations include:

- other NHS trusts and organisations
- ambulance service providers
- Social Services
- local authorities
- law enforcement agencies
- private sector service providers
- NHS England and NHS Digital

Before we send information, we make sure that we are allowed to share it with these partners by law, and that it will be protected. We check to make sure that each of our partners will look after the information as well as we do.

If the organisation does not need to know who individual patients are, we make sure that we take out any of these details before we send any information.

We also share information nationally so that NHS England can plan the best way to provide care to the whole country.

Using your information for research and clinical audits

We must carry out medical research to find new treatments and improve public health. Most of the time we can use information that does not show who the individual patients are, but sometimes we must know who they are. We check that all information used for research is protected and safe.

If you are happy for your information to be used for research, you do not have to do anything.
