Information for Patients

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If you have had local anaesthetic throat spray:

You must not eat or drink anything for 45 minutes because your throat will be numb and there is a risk of choking.

Do not eat or drink until:	
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If you have had sedative medicine:

For 12 hours you should:

be accompanied by a responsible adult.

For 24 hours do not:

- drive a car or ride a bicycle.
- drink alcohol.
- operate any machinery or do anything which needs skill or judgement.
- make important decisions or sign any documents.
- climb ladders.
- return to work until after this period of time.

General advice

- Go home and rest.
- The back of your throat may feel sore for the rest of the day.
- You may feel a little bloated if some air has remained in your stomach; this will pass.
- If you have any concerns, please contact your GP or the Endoscopy Department you attended (Monday to Friday, 8am to 6pm).

Go to your nearest Emergency Department immediately if you:

- have severe tummy (abdominal) pain.
- have severe chest pain.
- are vomiting blood or passing red or tarry black poo (stool).
- have a fever with or without shivering.

This is especially important if you are taking immunosuppressant drugs e.g. steroids, azathioprine, cyclophosphamide and methotrexate.
