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When can I eat or drink after my procedure?

You must not eat or drink anything for 45 minutes after having a local anaesthetic throat spray. Your throat will be numb and there is a risk of choking.

Do not eat or drink until: _____

If you have had sedative medicine:

For 12 hours you should:

• be accompanied by a responsible adult.

For 24 hours:

- do not drive a car or ride a bicycle.
- do not drink alcohol.
- do not use any machinery or do anything needing skill or judgement.
- do not make important decisions or sign any documents.
- do not climb ladders.
- do not return to work until after this period of time.

General advice

- Go home and rest.
- The back of your throat may feel sore for the rest of the day.
- You may have a sore nose, some bleeding and feel a little bloated if some air is in your stomach. This will pass.
- If you have any concerns, please contact your GP or the Endoscopy Department you attended.

When to get help

Go to your nearest Emergency Department immediately if you have any of the following (this is important if you are taking immunosuppressant drugs like steroids, azathioprine, cyclophosphamide or methotrexate):

- severe tummy (abdominal) pain.
- severe chest pain.
- vomiting blood or passing red or tarry black poo (stool).
- a fever with or without shivering.
