

Advice after a gastroscopy or endoscopic ultrasound (EUS)

Endoscopy Department

Information for Patients

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If you have had sedative medicine:

For 12 hours you should:

- be accompanied by a responsible adult.

For 24 hours:

- do not drive a car or ride a bicycle
- do not drink alcohol
- do not operate any machinery or do anything which needs skill or judgement
- do not make important decisions or sign any documents
- do not climb ladders
- do not return to work until after this period of time

General advice

- Go home and rest
- You must not eat or drink anything for 45 minutes after the local anaesthetic throat spray. Your throat will be numb and there is a risk of choking

Do not eat or drink until:

- The back of your throat may feel sore for the rest of the day
- You may feel a little bloated for the rest of the day if some air has stayed in your stomach; this will pass
- If you have any concerns, please contact your GP or the Endoscopy Department you attended

When to seek help

Go to your nearest Emergency Department immediately if you have any of the following (this is especially important if you are taking immunosuppressant drugs e.g. steroids, azathioprine, cyclophosphamide or methotrexate):

- Severe tummy (abdominal) pain
- Severe chest pain
- Vomiting blood
- Passing red or tarry black poo (stool)
- A fever with or without shivering
