If you have had sedative medicine:

For 12 hours you should:

- be accompanied by a responsible adult.

For 24 hours:

- do not drive a car or ride a bicycle.
- do not drink alcohol.
- do not operate any machinery or do anything which needs skill or judgement.
- do not make important decisions or sign any documents.
- do not climb ladders.
- do not return to work until after this period of time.

General advice

- Go home and rest.
- You may eat and drink as normal.
- You may feel a little bloated with wind pains but these often settle quickly. If not contact your GP.
- You may have mild diarrhoea for up to a week. If you have any bleeding that lasts longer than 2 days, please contact your GP.

When to seek help

Go to your nearest Emergency Department right away if you have any of the following symptoms:

- Severe tummy (abdominal) pain
- A lot of bleeding from your bottom
- Passing red or tarry black poo (stool)
- A fever with or without shivering

This is especially important if you are taking immunosuppressant drugs like steroids, azathioprine, cyclophosphamide or methotrexate.
