## If you have had sedative medicine:

#### For 12 hours you should:

be accompanied by a responsible adult.

#### For 24 hours:

- do not drive a car or ride a bicycle.
- do not drink alcohol.
- do not operate any machinery or do anything which needs skill or judgement.
- do not make important decisions or sign any documents.
- do not climb ladders.
- do not return to work until after this period of time.

#### **General advice**

- Go home and rest.
- You may eat and drink as normal.
- You may feel a little bloated with wind pains for the rest of the day, but these usually settle quickly; if not contact your GP.
- You may have mild diarrhoea for up to a week. If you have any bleeding that lasts longer than 2 days, please contact your GP.

## When to seek help

#### Go to your nearest Emergency Department immediately if you:

- have severe tummy (abdominal) pain.
- have significant tummy (abdominal) pain on your left side.
- have shoulder pain on your left side.
- have a lot of bleeding from your bottom.
- have a fever with or without shivering.

This is especially important if you are taking immunosuppressant drugs e.g. steroids, azathioprine, cyclophosphamide or methotrexate.
