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Introduction

Our service offers specialist nursing care for people who have had plastic surgery or burn injuries. We will support you while you are in hospital or clinic areas, but we can also support you at home, in other hospitals, schools and prisons.

You may be a patient on the ward who can go home earlier than planned. You may be a patient in the outpatient's department who has a wound that needs our specialist care. Or you could be a patient in the community who we can help so that you do not need to go back into hospital.

Our aims are to offer specialist wound care treatment at the best time in the best place for you and your family. The team of specialist nurses will offer clinical care, support and education to patients, carers, family and colleagues in the community.

We link in closely with the community teams and help smooth the change from hospital to home.

The aims of the 'Outreach Service'

- Bring patients back to Leicestershire, Rutland and Northamptonshire.
- Bringing patient care closer to home.
- Promoting early discharge from hospital.
- Prevention of admission to hospital.
- Actively involve patients with their own care.
- Promoting independence and recovery within the home environment.
- Involve and inform carers.
- Working with community teams such as district nurses.
