What is episcleritis?

Episcleritis is a condition where the outer layer over the white of the eye (the episclera) becomes inflamed. It usually affects only 1 eye.

What is the cause?

The cause is not known in most cases.

Some people who have other inflammatory conditions like arthritis are more likely to get episcleritis than others.

If episcleritis is severe and recurrent this may need to be investigated with blood tests.

What are the signs and symptoms?

These may include:

- Redness
- Pain
- Irritation
- Grittiness
- Tenderness in the affected eye

What is the treatment for episcleritis?

- In mild cases artificial tear drops work very well. These help to keep the eye more comfortable until the episcleritis clears up. You can buy these over the counter at any chemist.
- In most cases the eye will settle without any further treatment, usually in 2 to 3 weeks.
- At times you may need to be treated with steroidal or nonsteroidal antiinflammatory drops or even tablets. Episcleritis can recur but is not a sight threatening condition.
